

In partnership with CareerStep, the WHS Phlebotomy Training Program provides you with a great education and guarantees you a job post-graduation\*.

New classes start throughout the year, and we typically accept around 4-5 students per class, based on applications and interviews.

## How does the training program work?

Students are hired as full-time WHS employees and work 40 hours per week, earning a paycheck right from the start. This program includes both online and in-person clinical training. Time to complete the online portion of the program is approximately 4-6 weeks, followed up by onsite hands-on clinical training, alongside the WHS Phlebotomy Team, giving you both inpatient and outpatient care experience.

## What happens after graduation?

\*Post-graduation and successful completion of the state phlebotomy board exam, all students are guaranteed a full-time position.

## How much does it cost?

NOTHING! If accepted to the program, WHS covers the costs for online classes through CareerStep for participants and onsite training. All while you are already earning a salary.
