Dr. Jon and Carol Adler's 50 Year Commitment and a Legacy Gift to Support Washington Health System

Jon Adler, MD, a retired Family Medicine Physician, and his wife Carol's love for Washington Health System, began when Jon completed a junior internship at Washington Hospital in 1963. The Canonsburg native and Washington & Jefferson graduate was studying at Philadelphia's Jefferson Medical School. After graduation, they decided Washington Hospital was the best choice for establishing a practice.

Jon served as Chair of Washington Hospital's Department of Family Medicine, Medical Staff President, Washington Hospital Board of Trustees' Medical Staff Representative, and later a Board Trustee. He retired in 1999. Carol volunteered at the Washington Hospital, in its Medical Staff Library, and at WHS Primary Care – Lakeside in McMurray.

The Adlers began supporting Washington Health System over fifty years ago and have given every year since. They have also chosen to make a legacy gift by including Washington Hospital in their will. Their motivation was giving to a facility that has meant a lot to them while stressing the importance of maintaining independence.

"I want Washington Hospital to continue to be the fine facility where I was a patient and always treated with respect," Carol said.

"When I was on the Medical Staff and Hospital Board, there were discussions about affiliation with a larger Pittsburgh hospital," Jon said. "But Washington Hospital was doing very well on its own. We could do better with cost containment for our patients, and we did."

Thanks to Jon and Carol's philanthropic support, Washington Health System will remain a first-class independent health system providing patient care in local communities into the future.

Sparking Improvements in our Health System

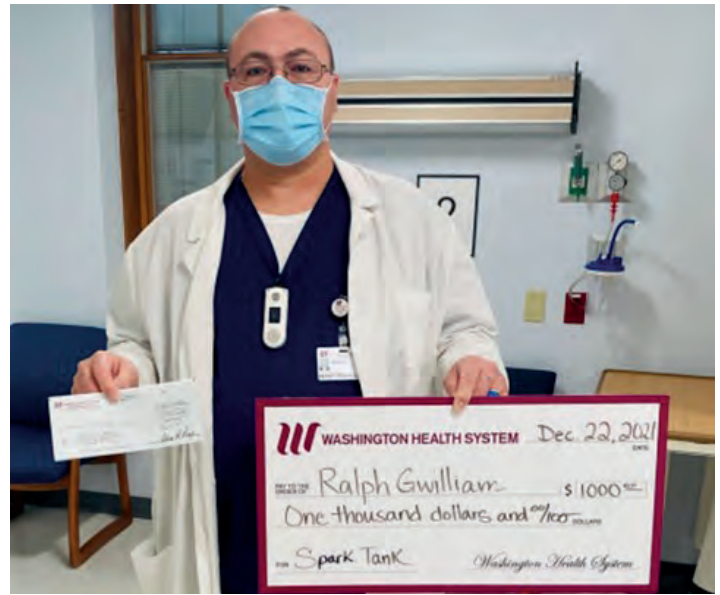
The Spark Tank Contest, sponsored by Washington Auto Mall, recently announced the winner of the most recent competition.

Chartered in 1897, The Washington Hospital began in a two-story brick building on Acheson Avenue. With only five patient rooms and two wards, the Hospital could only care for 20 patients at a time.

As Washington and the surrounding area began to grow, The Washington Hospital was able to grow with it – through the generosity of the community. Washington Health System now provides healthcare services at more than 40 off-site locations throughout three counties.

In 2010, Mr. Camlin had a massive heart attack, a “widow maker,” because 70% of those having that type of heart attack don’t make it to the hospital. Mr. Camlin quickly arrived at the hospital and was rushed to Washington Hospital’s Cardiac Cath Lab. In less than an hour from the beginning of his heart attack, he had a stent placed that opened his artery to 100% and was in the Critical Care Unit for recovery.
